Know all men by these presents, that Foster and Barr, parties of Skamania Countyk State of Washington, the parties of the first part, Gold, Coin of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the Portland Manufacturing Company, a Corporation of Oregon, doing business at St. Johns, Oregon, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns all of the following described personal property towit: One team of horses, one horse called Joe, bay horse and one horse called Bill, a black horse, and set double harness for this team, the horse called Joe is about 9 years old and the horse called Bill is about 7 years old. Also one team of horses, called Frank and George and double set harness for team, Frank is a bay horse about 10 years 10 years old and George is buckskin or mouse color horse about 10 years old. Also six head of yearling cattle, two heifers and four steers, also a two year old heifer and two year old bull now on place of F.F. Foster near Stevenson, Wash. To have and to hold the same to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever. And we do, for ourselves, heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby made under the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, against all and every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
