

Agreement in Triplicate

This Agreement, made by and between and entered into this the seventh day of November, A.D. 1905, by and between Mike Thornton of the first part, A. G. Ames of the second part, and Moses Thornton of the third part, Witnesses: For and in consideration of the agreements and considerations and stipulations hereinafter set forth the parties hereto do by this agreement form a company to be known as Ames, Thornton and Company, and the purpose of this company and its business is which it intends to engage, is the Mining Business, operating the mine already located as the "Elkhorn" Mine in an unorganized Mining District in Skamania County, State of Washington, now owned by all the parties hereto in equal undivided parts, and locating other mining claims in said Mining District; and we do jointly and severally agree that any and all mines or parts of mines located by any one of us, or by any one for us, shall be a location for the said Company, to each one of us share and share alike; that the said Moses Thornton and the said A. G. Ames for their part shall do all the work in developing the claim now owned or other claims to be hereafter located for the space of one year, and during said time the said Mike Thornton for his part shall furnish the grub stake and the powder used in said work; and at the close of said year or sooner the said Company shall be merged into a Corporation to be known as the "Elkhorn Mining Company", and the said corporation shall be organized at and the principal place of business shall be the Town of Underwood, State of Washington, and the said parties wish that John Selward Henderson shall prepare the articles of incorporation and act as the attorney for said corporation during its organization and operation; the profits and losses of the said enterprise during said year of experimental work, to be shared equally between the parties hereto.
