Said Mrs. Turner to pay for the delivery of said wood on to the scow belonging to Maier & Phanno at the mouth of the flume.

To have and to hold the same unto the said party of the second part, executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I do for his heirs, executors and administrators and agree to and with said party of the second part his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby sold unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
