Lewis Clark, the parties of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns, all of the following described personal property to-wit:

All my stock of merchandise and store fixtures in the store building situated on Lot 2 of the Town of Underwood Skamania County, Washington. To have and to hold the same to the said parties of the second part, their executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I do for my heirs, executors and administrators, covenant and agree, to and with the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, executors and administrators, to warrant and defend the sale of said property, goods and chattels hereby made unto the said parties of the second part their executors, administrators and assigns, against all and every person and persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same;
