## Right of Way Agreement

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the undersigned on hand paid, the receipt of which do hereby acknowledge, and the further sum of Two hundred Dollars, to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned have agreed, and by these presents do agree, on written request within six months from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation free and clear of all encumbrances, a right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land one hundred feet in width, being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company as located, staked out and to be constructed over and across: - Lot two (2) Section thirty-two (32) Township three (3) North, Oregon New York W. M. and the shorelands adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said shore lands contained within said strip, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across said premises from lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strip, and upon payment of and sum of Two hundred Dollars agree to make a good and sufficient deed to said Company for said strip, the Company to have the right to enter and construct its road across said premises in the mean time.
