Right of Way Agreement.

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of ~~\$1000~~ One thousand Dollars, to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned have agreed, and by these presents do agree, on written request within three months from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington Corporation free and clear of all incumbrances, a right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land one hundred feet in width, being fifty feet in width on each side of the center line of said railroad of said Railway Company as located, staked out and to be constructed over and across:— Lot four ~~47~~ Section Thirty-two and Lots One ~~1~~ Two ~~2~~ Three ~~3~~ and four ~~4~~ Section Thirty-three ~~33~~ all in Township three ~~3~~ North of Range Nine ~~9~~ East W. M., and the shorelands adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said shorelands contained within said strip, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across said premises from lands outside of said adjacent to the above described strip, and upon payment of said sum of \$1000. ~~00~~ One thousand Dollars agree to make a good and sufficient deed to said Company for said strip, the Company to have the right to enter and construct its road across said premises in the manner shown.
