

Right of Way Agreement

In consideration of the sum of one dollar to us as hereinafter provided, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of Four hundred Dollars (\$400.00) to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned, we have agreed and by these presents do agree, on written request, within six months from date, to sell and convey to the Columbia River and Navigation Company free and clear of all encumbrances, a right of way for its road over and across the Southwest quarter of Section 29, and Lot 1 (one) of Section 32, all in Township 3 N. Range 1 East of T. 11., consisting of a strip of land one hundred (100) feet wide, being Fifty (50) feet on each side of the center line of the road of said Company as located and staked out or may hereafter be located, across said premises, and upon payment of said sum of \$400.00 agree to make a good and sufficient deed to said Company for said right of way, the Company to have the right to enter and construct its road across said premises in the meantime.

Should the said Company fail to exercise this option to purchase said right of way within six months from the date hereof, then this agreement shall be null and void.
