

J. W. Stevenson to Geo. F. Brodin.

Lease and Agreement.

This agreement made and entered into this 9th day of Sept. 1905 by and between John W. Stevenson
party of the first part and Geo. F. Brodin, party of the second part, Minnesota:

That for and in consideration of the sum of \$5.00 the said party of the first part has agreed to
lease and hereby does lease to the said party of the second part the following described premises:
A strip of land 200 feet wide along the north side of the survey of the proposed railroad across
the land owned by said party of the first part at Baye Horn, Wash., and lease to be for the term
of 10 years with the privilege of five years more at end of said 10 years. It is further and
expressly agreed by the said party of the first part that he will give and hereby does give the
said party of the second part the exclusive right for any and all merchandise, saloon and hotel
business to be carried on at and on all lands owned by said party of the first part at Baye
Horn, Washington, during the term of this lease. The party of the second part does hereby agree
to pay the sum of \$60.00 per year for said leased premises, payable on March 1st of every year.
