

Mrs Josephine Swanson to P. & S. Ry. Co.

Right of Way Agreement.

In consideration of the sum of one dollar to the undersigned in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of (\$800.00) Eight Hundred Dollars, to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned have agreed and and by these presents do agree, on written request within three months from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway company, or Washington Corporation free and clear of all encumbrances a right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land 100 feet in width, being 50 ft in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said railway company as located, staked out and to be constructed over and across. Lot 44 of Section Six Township one North Range One East Willamette. And said railway company agrees to build crossings for said grantee in the most practicable place. Also to build and maintain fence on each side of the Railroad track and the share lands adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said share lands contained within said strip, and upon payment of said sum above mentioned agree to make a good and

sufficient deed to said Company for said strip, the Company
to have the right to enter and construct its road across said
premises in the meantime.
