



Right of way agreement.

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the undersigned is here paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and the further sum of Nine hundred $\$900.00$ Dollars, to be paid on the execution of this deed hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned has agreed and by these presents do agree, on written request within two months from date, to sell and convey to the undersigned said Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation free and clear of all encumbrances, a right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land 100 feet in width, being 50 feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company as located, or may hereafter be located, staked out and to be constructed over and across lots 1, 2, 3 and four Sec. 31 Twp. 3 North Range 8 East W.M. Above named company further agree to provide wagon road crossing across said Right of way or premises, and the stockyards adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said stockyards contained within said strip, and upon payment of said sum above mentioned agree to make a good and sufficient Deed to said Company for said strip, the Company to have the right to enter and construct its road across said premises in the manner here.
