He and all Men by these Presents, That we, the undersigned, for a valuable consideration, hereby lease to the Wind River Lumber Company, a Corporation of the State of Nevada, its successors and assigns, for a period of fifteen years from date hereof, the right and privileges to cater upon the banks of Wind River in Section Twenty-eight, Township three North of Range eight East, in Stanislaus County, Washington, and in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of said section, for the purpose of logging and removing any and all timber products that may hereafter be lodged or stranded on the banks of said stream, together with the right and privilege to drive logs and other timber products down said stream across said Section Twenty-eight by means of natural or artificial freshets. Provided, a reasonable sum be paid the undersigned for any damage done to said banks caused by such freshets.
