

Right of Way Agreement

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar & the undersigned is here paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of Six hundred £600.-7 Dollars, to be paid on the execution of the said hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned have agreed and by these presents do agree, a written request within four months from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington Corporation, free and clear of all encumbrances, a right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land 100 feet in width, being 50 feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company, as located, staked out and to be constructed over and across: one acre of land in lot 5 Sec. 25 Town 2 North Range 6 East Willamette river our aye being all the land owned by us in lot 5 at present time, and the aforesaid agreement thereby, including the preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said strip contained within said strip, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across said premises from lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strip, and upon payment of said sum above mentioned agree to make a good and sufficient deed to said Company for said strip, the Company to have the right to enter and construct its road across said premises in the manner.
