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Right of Way Agreement

In consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars (\$100.00) paid to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of two hundred (\$200.00) to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter named, the undersigned have agreed and by these presents do agree, on condition resugnt within five months from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation free and clear of all covenants, a right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land 100 feet in width being 50 feet in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company as located, staked out and to be confirmed over and across. All that portion of land in the Robbins J. L. C. owned by user in Sec. 35 Twp. 3 N. R. 8. E. W. M. above named company further agrees granted resugnt the right to pipe water under track across said right of way; also to provide wagon road crossing across said right of way on said land, and the shortest alignment thereto, including the preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said short road contained in said strip of land, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across said premises from lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strips and upon payment of such sum above mentioned agree to make a good and sufficient deed to said Company for said strips, the Company to have the right to enter and about its road across said premises in the meantime.
