In consideration of the sum of one dollar to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of Two Hundred (\$200) dollars to be paid on the execution of the deed herein after mentioned,

the undersigned have agreed by their presents to agree on written request within two weeks from date to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington Corporation, free and clear of all incumbrances a right of way for its railroad, consisting of Lot Number (10) ten, in block number five in the town of Stevenson, Skamania Co., State of Washington, a showing of official plat, now of record in the Co. Auditor's office in said County and State.

And upon payment of said sum above mentioned agree to make a good and sufficient deed to said Company for said land.
