

the undersigned have agreed and by the presents do
agree, on written request within two months from date, to
sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company
a Washington Corporation, free and clear of all incumbrances:
Lots seven and eight Block numbered five of the Town of
Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington, as shown by
the Official Plot of said town now of record in the office
of the Auditor of said County, and the shore lands
adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the un-
dersigned to purchase the portion of said shore lands con-
tained within said strip, together with the privilege of
obtaining necessary material for construction of said
railroad across said premises from lands outside of and
adjacent to the above described strip, and upon payment

move all furnishings in building.


