Right of Way Agreement

In consideration of the sum of one Dollar to the undersigned in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of One Thousand (1000) Dollars, to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned have agreed and by these presents do agree, on written request within two months from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington Corporation free from and clear of all incumbrances, Lots numbered eleven and twelve in Block numbered five of the Town of Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington, as shown by the official plat of said Town now of record, in the office of the Auditor of said County, and the shore lands adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said shore lands contained within said strips, and upon payment of said sum above mentioned agreed to make good and sufficient deed to said Company for said strips. Seller's Retain Right to Remain in Possession for a month from date of Payment without Payment of Rent. Seller may remove all furnishings in Building.
