

A. Fleischhauer to Portland & Seattle Co. Co.

Right of Way Agreement

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of Fourteen Hundred (\$1400⁰⁰) Dollars, to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned have agreed and by these presents do agree, on written request within two months from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington Corporation free and clear of all incumbrances, All land owned by me joining to Town of Stevenson, in Henry Shepard D.L.C. Sec. 1, Twp. 2, N.R. 7, E.W.M. and the above lands adjacent thereto, including the preferential right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said shore lands contained within said strip, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across said premises from lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strip, and upon payment of said sum above mentioned agree to make good and sufficient deed to said company for said strip.
