

Olof Sholin & wife to P. Y. L. Co.

Right of Way Agreement

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of One Thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars, to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned the undersigned have agreed and by these presents do agree, on written request within two months from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington Corporation, free from and clear of all incumbrances, Lot numbered nine, in Block five of the Town of Stevenson, Skamania County, Washington, as shown by the official plat of said said Town and of record in the office of the Auditor of said County. And the shore lands adjacent thereto, including ^{the} preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portion of said shore lands contained within said strip, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across said premises from lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strip, and upon payment of said sum as above mentioned agree to make good and sufficient deed to said Company for said strip, the Company to have the right, Sellers retain Right to remain in Possession six months from date of Payment without Payment of Rent. Sellers may remove all furnishings in building.
