## Rules and Regulations

- 1. The lots in this cemetery are designed for the burial of only such persons or their families, as have paid for and obtained a certificate entitling them to the use of the same, and when resold, must be sold to the District at the original purchaser's price.
- 2. No person shall be allowed to erect any concrete curbing or fence or any unsightly or otherwise obnoxious structure or set out or plant any trees, plants or shrubbery within these grounds.
- 3. All future grave markers shall be of the single flush type, set at ground level. All markers shall be set by an authorized personnel of the District at the prevailing price.
- 4. The District will not be responsible for artificial flowers and wreaths of the same material, that have not been securely fastened and are blown away by the wind. These are dangerous and get caught in our mowing machines.
- 5. Please refrain from using glass jars or tin cans for flower containers. We suggest plastic or milk cartons.
- 6. From April first to October first live flowers only will be allowed except for Memorial Day and ten days immediately thereafter. They then must be removed or the District will not be responsible for them.
