

Right of Way Agreement.

In consideration of the sum of one dollar to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of Three hundred & (\$300) dollars, to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter executed, the undersigned have agreed and by these presents do agree, on written request within 10 days from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington Corporation, free and clear of all encumbrances, a right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land 80 feet in width, lying 40 feet on each side of present Right of way, in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of said Railway Company, as located, stated out and to be constructed over and across Lots five and six in Sec. 31 Twp. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. 16. Beginning at Station 1551 thence to 1558 being seven hundred feet in length, also in Sec. 36 Twp. 3 N. R. 7 1/2 E. Beginning at 1636 thence 1643 being seven hundred feet in length, and the shorelands adjacent thereto, together with the privilege of obtaining necessary material for construction of said railroad across said premises from lands outside of and adjacent to the above described strips, and upon payment of said sum above mentioned agree to make a good and sufficient deed to said Company for said strips, the company to have the right to enter and construct its road across said premises in the meanwhile.
