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R. S. Gould to Col. Vall. R.R. Co.

Know all men by these presents That R. S. Gould and Florence O. Gould, his wife both of the County of Wasco, in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, paid by the Columbia Valley Railroad Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Washington, having its principal office at the City of Vancouver in the said State, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Columbia Valley Railroad Company, its successors and assigns the following described parcel of land, situate in Skamania County, State of Washington to-wit: A strip of land 100 feet in width, being 50 feet in width on each side of and parallel with, the center line of the main track of its road as the same is staked out and located over and across the lands of the said R. S. Gould and

Florence B. Gould, her wife, resides in Clallamia County, State of Washington and known and designated as follows:

Lot One (1) in Section Twenty nine (29) Township three (3) North Range Eight (8) East. It is further understood and agreed that this Deed does not cover any land hereafter sold to the Portland and Seattle Ry Co. That if in the course of the construction of the Columbia Valley Rail Road it becomes necessary to move the buildings on said lot i namely one saloon building and one hotel such building shall be moved or rebuilt at some suitable location on said lot 1 not to exceed 100 feet north or south of their present location, at the expense of the Columbia Valley R. R. Co. That this Deed is given upon the further condition that the grantees pay the further sum of One hundred and seventy-five $\frac{25}{100}$ Dollars to the grantor within one year from date, otherwise these presents become null and void. It is further agreed that the grantees shall have the right to enter at once on the premises and construct said Railroad. Grantees reserve all mineral and hot spring rights with rights to develop same with right of uses, but in such manner as not to interfere with said railroad. To have and to hold the said described premises unto the said Company its successors and assigns forever, for the purpose of building and maintaining a railroad thereon and to use the same for all legitimate railroad purposes.
