Know all men by these presents that I John Tieo of Stevenson Skamania County State of Washington for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and seventy five dollars to me in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged have this day bargain sold and do by these presents bargain sell assign convey and forever set over unto Maier & Beuton of The Dalles Oregon the following described personal property towit: Viz:

One Hundred cords of fir wood, One Black Horse (Nig) the black horse sold to Tio by J.T. Peters & Co. in 1893 One large cord wood or Lumber wagon to have and to hold the above mentioned personal property to their own personal use and benefit without let or hinderance of or by my person or persons what soever and that I will warrant and defend the said Maier & Beuton in the lawful ownership of said personal property against the claim or demands of all persons whatsoever said wood abovescribed being now at or near my house in the woods and the horse and wagon on or near my place at Stevenson the wagon is the one purchased from Mays & Crowe 1892 or 1893 as their Books show.
