

Right of Way Agreement

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the undersigned in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of (\$2000.00) two thousand dollars, to be paid on the execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned have agreed and by these presents do agree in writing to request within one month from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, a Washington corporation, free and clear of all incumbrances a right of way for its railroad consisting of a strip of land 200 feet in width, being 100 feet in width on each side of the Right-of-way now owned by the Portland and Seattle Railway Company over and across the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 29 Twp. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. 4, also a strip of land for a right of way 100 feet wide being 50 feet wide on each side of the right of way now owned by the Portland and Seattle Railway Company over and across Lot One in Section 32, Twp. 3 N. R. 8 E. W. 4, and the shorelands adjacent thereto, including the preference right of the undersigned to purchase the portions of said shorelands contained in said strips; and upon payment of said sum above mentioned agree to make good and sufficient deed to said Company for said strips the Company to have the right to enter and construct its road across said premises in the meantime.
