

Agreement for Sale of Timber

I hereby agree to sell to J.P. Parker & Co., or as before January 1st 1907 the following described property; All standing and fallen timber on W<sup>2</sup> of S.E.<sup>4</sup> Section 7 T. 3 N R 10 E. W.M.S. 20 acres of said timber to be removed within 5 yrs, and balance within next 7 years. I agree to give free rights of way for flumes and roads wherever necessary in logging, outside of clearing. J.P. Parker to pay taxes on timber and land until timber is removed, for the consideration of \$1000, cash to be paid as hereafter stated.

I agree to furnish said J.P. Parker & Co., within 3 months from date, an abstract to said property.

The said J.P. Parker & Co., has deposited with me \$100, which I will credit him with on the purchase price, should said company complete the purchase; otherwise I will retain the said \$100, as liquidated damages, also a further sum of \$200, to be paid on Oct. 15, 1906.
