

Agreement for sale of Timber

I hereby agree to sell to J.P. Parler & Co, on or before January 1st 1907 the following described property; All standing and fallen timber on S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 6 in T. 3 N. R. 10 E. W.M, 20 acres of said timber to be removed within 5 yrs, and balance to be removed within next 7 yrs. I agree to furnish free rights of way for flumes and roads whenever necessary for logging purposes. J.P. Parler ~~to~~ to pay taxes on said timber and land until said timber is removed, for the sum of \$3800, cash to be paid as hereinafter stated.

I agree to furnish said J.P. Parler & Co, an abstract to said property before or at time of purchase.

The said J.P. Parler & Co. has deposited with me \$100, which I will credit them with on the purchase price, should they complete the purchase; otherwise I will retain the said \$100, as liquidated damages. Also a further sum of \$200, to be paid Oct. 15, 1906.
