

Agreement for sale of Timber.

I hereby agree to sell J.P. Paster & Co., or as before January 1st 1907  
 the following described property; All standing and fallen timber on S.E.<sup>4</sup> of N.W.<sup>4</sup>  
 & S.W.<sup>4</sup> of N.E.<sup>4</sup> & S<sup>2</sup> of N.W.<sup>4</sup> of N.E.<sup>4</sup> Sec. 9 T. 32, R 10 E W.M., 20 acres of  
 said timber to be removed within 5 yrs, and balance within next 7 yrs.  
 I agree to furnish free rights of way for flume and roads wherever necessary on  
 said land for logging purposes. J.P. Paster to pay all taxes on said timber & land  
 until said timber is removed, for the sum of \$15.80, cash to be paid as hereafter  
 stated.

I agree to furnish said J.P. Paster & Co., within 3 months from date, an  
 abstract to said property.

The said J.P. Paster & Co., has deposited with me \$8100, which I will credit  
 them with on the purchase price should they complete the purchase; otherwise  
 I will retain the said \$8100, as liquidated damages, also a further \$200,  
 to be paid on Oct. 15, 1906.
