

Agreement for sale of timber.

I, hereby agree to sell to J.P. Paulin & Co; or on before January 1st /907 the following described property; All standing and fallen timber on Lot 3, and S.E.⁴ of N.W.⁴ and N.2.⁴ of S.W.⁴ in Sec. 6 T 3 N, R.10 E. W.M., 20 acres of said timber to be removed within 6 yrs. Balance to be removed within next 7 yrs. I agree to furnish free rights of way for flumes and roads on said land wherever necessary for logging purposes. J.P. Paulin to pay taxes on said timber and land until said timber is removed, for the sum of \$2570, cash to be paid as hereinbefore stated.

I agree to furnish said J.P. Paulin & Co, an abstract to said property before or at time of purchase.

The said J.P. Paulin & Co, has deposited with me \$100, which I will credit them with on the purchase price, should they complete the purchase; otherwise I will retain the said \$100, as liquidated damages. Also a further sum of \$200, to be paid Oct. 15, 1906. Provided, said Jan. 1st, 1907 payment not to be made until patent received and recorded.
