

Agreement for sale of timber.

I, hereby agree to sell to J.P. Putin & Co., on or before January 1<sup>st</sup> 1907 the following described property; All the standing and fallen timber on S<sup>2</sup>g N.E.<sup>4</sup> and S<sup>2</sup>g N.W.<sup>4</sup> excepting therefore S<sup>1</sup>g S.E.<sup>4</sup> of N.E.<sup>4</sup> all in sec. 5 T 3 N, R 10 E, W.M. I also agree to give free rights of way over and across my lands for flumes and roads wherever necessary for logging. Said timber to be removed in 5 years with an additional 7 years if necessary, 20 acres to be removed in first 5 yrs. Balance in next 7 yrs. J.P. Putin to pay taxes on timber and land until timber is removed.

I agree to furnish J.P. Putin & Co., within 3 months from date, an abstract to said property.

The said J.P. Putin & Co., has deposited with me \$100, which I will credit him with on the purchase price should said company complete the purchase, otherwise I will retain the said \$100, as liquidated damages. Also \$200, to be paid on Oct. 15, 1907.
