

Agreement for sale of timber.

I hereby agree to sell to J.P. Partin & Co., or before January 1st 1907 the following described property: All the standing and fallen timber on E "W." of Sec. 9 T 3 N, R 10 E, W.M., together with five rights of way over said land for flumes and all roads necessary for logging, except in clearing. Said timber to be removed within 5 years, with an additional 7 years if necessary. 20 acres to be removed within 5 years and balance in next 7 years. J.P. Partin to pay all taxes on land and timber until timber is removed, for the sum of \$800, cash on delivery of deed, deed not to be given until patent received.

I agree to furnish J.P. Partin & Co. within 3 months from date an abstract to said property.

The said J.P. Partin & Co. has deposited with me \$100, which I will credit him with on the purchase price, should they complete the purchase, otherwise I will retain the said \$100, as liquidated damages.
