 acknowledged do hereby sell assign transfer and set over
 unto Maier & Benton of the Dalles Wasco County Oregon
 One hundred and twenty cords of Fir wood more or less
 said wood is now situated on Jo Teco and Chas. Teco's
 claim near Stevenson Skamania County Wash. To have and
 to hold the same unto their own personal use and benefit
 forever and that we will defend the said Maier & Benton
 against the claim of any person or persons or corporation
 in the lawful ownership of said wood, Maier & Benton
 are to pay fifty cents per cord for hauling said wood
 to landing for scow if not hauled by July 1st 1894 Maier
 & Benton have right to put in team and haul said wood
 themselves or hire other parties to haul said wood to
