

Agreement for right of way.

This agreement made and entered into this 5th day of October 1906 between John Frasse party of the first part and John H. Sweeney party of the second part, witnesseth:

That the said party of the first part for the consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does covenant and agree with the party of the second part, that the party of the first part will give and grant unto the said second part, a right of way for logging, hauling and other purposes necessary in the operation of and conveyance of timber to and from said second parties saw mill, over and across the following described land, to-wit: The northeast quarter of the northwest quarter of section no 25 Township No 3 north of Range No. 7 East of Willamette meridian. The party of the first part grants to the party of the second part a right of way for a period of 3 years from above date Oct. 5th 1906, and the party of the second part agrees to fence right of way with Bar wire and wire and fence to be the property of party of first part at the expiration of three years. The party of the second part also agrees to remove skids from right of way within 3 years. This contract not transferable to other parties.

Agreement for sale of timber.

This agreement made and entered into this 5th day of Oct. 1906 by and between John H. Sweeney party of the first part and Ed Learned party of the second part, witnesseth;

That the said party of the first part hereby agrees to pay the said ^{party of the} second party the sum of One Dollar per thousand feet for every hundred thousand feet of timber logged off the following described land now owned by said party of the second part. This includes all the timber now owned by party of the second part that is merchantable saw timber in Sec. 24 Twp. 3 No. Ra 7 Ea W. M.
