

Agreement for right of Way.

This Agreement made and entered into this 5th day of Oct. 1906 between El. Learned party of the first part and John F. Sweeney party of the second part, witnesseth;
 That said party of the first part for the consideration of One Dollar to him paid by the party of the second part the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does covenant and agree with the party of the second part, that the party of the first part will give and grant unto the said second party a right of way for logging, hauling and any other purposes necessary in the operation of and conveyance of timber or supplies to and from said second parties saw mill; Said first party also agrees to furnish a mill site for said second parties saw mill if said second party so desires.

This agreement is to remain in full force and effect so long as said mill is in operation, unless sooner terminated by the mutual agreement of the parties hereto.

This agreement is effective on, over and across the following described land to-wit;

It is further agreed that the party of the second part agrees to and binds himself to take all merchantable timber now owned by party of the first part in Sec. 24, Town 3 No. R. 7 E. W. Meridian.
