Right of Way Agreement.

In consideration of the sum of One Dollar to the undersigned in hand
 paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and the further sum of
 Twelve Hundred and forty nine (\$1249.00) Dollars to be paid on the
 execution of the deed hereinafter mentioned, the undersigned have agreed
 and by these presents do agree, on written request within one month
 from date, to sell and convey to the Portland and Seattle Railway Company,
 a Washington Corporation, free and clear of all encumbrances, a right of way
 for its railroad consisting of a strip of land three hundred feet in width, being
 150 ft in width on each side of the center line of the railroad of the said
 Railway Company, as located, staked out and to be constructed over and across:
