Hickock And Co. party of the second part: Witness that the party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and Eighty four and Eighty three cents \$484.83 have bargained sold and delivered unto the said party of the second part six hundred cords of wood now on what is known as Smith Creek in the County of Skamania State of Washington.

To have and to hold the same unto the heirs & assigns of the said C.G. Hickok & Co. and claim and assigns forever the above described property.
