It is hereby agreed between the Columbia Valley Railroad Company, Louis Gerlinger and Sophia Gerlinger, his wife, and E. M. Rands and Margaret C. Rands, his wife, parties of the first part, and the Portland and Seattle Railway Company, party of the second part, in consideration of the agreement this day made between said parties as to the amount to be awarded as compensation for the condemnation and appropriation of certain lands for railway purposes by the party of the second part in a certain suit pending in the Superior Court of the State of Washington for the County of Skamania, entitled "Portland and Seattle Railway Company, Petitioner, vs Louis Gerlinger, et al., Claimants," that the said party of the second part shall have the same right to occupy, for the slope of any fill necessary for the construction of its railway as now staked out and located over land owned by the parties of the first part and situated more than one hundred feet from the center of the railway of said party of the second part and that said second party shall have right to occupy the premises condemned in said proceeding; and, if the judgment of condemnation entered in said proceeding shall be affirmed by the Supreme Court of Washington

either upon review or appeal, or if no proceeding shall be taken to set aside the same, then the Portland and Seattle Railway Company shall thereafter have the right to maintain its slopes upon said premises, and no claim shall be made by the parties of the first part for compensation therefor.

The land referred to above, upon which the foregoing right and privilege is granted, is described as follows, to-wit: Lots 3 and 4 in section 25, township 3 north of range east, St. M. Lot 13 in section 36, township 3 north of range 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ east, St. M. The west half of lot 2 in section 29, township 3 north of range 8 east, St. M. And on lots 3 and 4 in section 29, township 3 north of range 8 east, W. M., as conveyed to Louis Gerlinger by deed dated November 29, 1905, by Emile Fessler and wife, which deed is recorded in Book I of Deeds, Page 289, of the records of Skamania County.
