To have and to hold from month to month, yielding and paying therefor the rent of \$5⁰⁰ monthly in advance.

Received of C. E. Leman, by Goodnough & Stearns, Agent, the sum of one hundred and no/100 Dollars, in part payment of the following described real property situated in the County of Stacumarin State of Washington - to-wit:

All of the Northwest quarter of Section Thirty three (33) in Township Three (3) North of Range six (6) East of Willamette Meridian, at the agreed purchase price of Thirty two thousand (\$3200.⁰⁰) Dollars, upon the following terms and conditions: -

The undersigned owners of the above described premises hereby guarantee that the said premises will contain six million five hundred thousand feet of merchantable timber of the following kinds, quantities and qualities to-wit: Seventy-five (75%) yellow Fir and balance Spruce. And their agreement of purchase of sale is made upon the express condition: The said owners agree to furnish a full, true and correct abstract of title of said premises to the said purchaser, showing title in fee simple in the undersigned vendors, free from all liens, incumbrances and defects, and upon payment of the balance of said purchase price, to-wit: The sum of Thirty one thousand (\$3100.⁰⁰) Dollars at Bank of Bowells at Bonnell's South Dakota less Five per cent on \$3200.⁰⁰ as agents commission, on or before sixty days from date hereof, to make, execute and deliver unto said C. E. Leman

his heirs or assigns, a good and sufficient deed of warranty, to the said premises, signed by the undersigned, R. Blain and wife, conveying the same as aforesaid. The said purchaser shall have the right to have the timber now standing upon said premises covered by such person or persons as he may select, and if the report of such owner or owners shall show a less or different character, quantity or quality of timber than as herein specified, or if the title to said premises should prove defective and the said owner cannot deliver a good title to said premises as aforesaid, within the time herein specified or such longer time as may be granted therefore by said purchaser, then and in that case, the amount herein received for shall upon demand be immediately repaid unto the said S. E. Leman, or his legal representatives, by the undersigned owners of said premises, their heirs, executors, or administrators or assigns: The purchaser aforesaid shall however have the right to extend the time for final payment for any reasonable time for the purpose of the seller perfecting the title, in case of any defects therein that can be cured, and in such case the seller agrees to take immediate action to perfect title as his or her own expense.
