Know all men by these presents that Underwood Mining Company, a Washington Corporation, Angus Underwood, Edward Underwood and John Sack all of Underwood, Skamania Co. Washington, the party of the first part, for and in consideration of one (1) dollar to them in hand paid, do hereby bargain and grant to Frank Underwood of Astoria, State of Iowa, the party of the second part for the period of Five (5) months from the date hereof the sole, exclusive and irrevocable right and privilege of purchasing all those certain tracts or parcels of land, situated and lying in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, and more particularly bounded and described as follows:

Five (5) certain Mining claims known and designated on the records of Skamania County aforesaid, as Gold dollar claim "July Jack claim" "Ruth" "Wade Sam claim", "Sakell claim" which were entered by Angus Underwood John Sack, Edward A. Underwood and Charles Myers, also first certain County claims known and designated on said records as would one (1) "Black Jack" "Apple Jack" and "Morning Star" claims entered in the names of John Sack and W. Underwood and Ed. Underwood, respectively, in Negros' Head unorganized Mining District, at and for the agreed price of fifty Thousand (\$50,000) dollars to be paid (if said party of the second part shall elect to purchase hereunder)
