Thomas H. Menice to W. O. Hadley & S. S. Hayes.

this agreement made and entered into this 14<sup>th</sup> day of February  
 1908 by and between Thomas H. Menice party of the first part  
 and W. O. Hadley and S. S. Hayes, parties of the second  
 part, all of Collins, Skamania County Washington, for the pur-  
 pose of establishing a line between Lot No. Four (4), Section  
 Thirty-five (35) and Lot No. 1, Section Thirty-six (36), Township  
 Three (3) North of Range Eight (8) East of the Willamette  
 Meridian, in Skamania County, State of Washington, for  
 and in consideration of the sum of Ten dollars (\$10.00) to  
 him in hand paid by W. O. Hadley and S. S. Hayes, receipt  
 of which is hereby acknowledged, party of the first part  
 being the owner of all of lot No. Four (4), above mentioned,  
 lying on the South side of the Portland and Seattle Rail-  
 road right-of-way, according to an agreement entered

into by road between the Portland and Seattle Rail-road Co. (by their attorney James B. Kerr) on the 11th day of May 1907, which said agreement is recorded in Book 1 of Agreements, page 482, Records of Auditor of Skamania County, State of Washington; agree with the parties of the second part that the said line between said lot Four (4) Section thirty-five (35) and lot One (1), Section thirty-six (36), Township Three (3) North of Range Eight (8) East of the Willamette Meridian, shall start from a stake situated one hundred & sixty (60) feet, due South of the center of a large rock on the North side of the Portland and Seattle Rail-road company right-of-way, said rock being about thirty (30) feet long and about fifteen (15) feet high and fifteen (15) feet wide and the West side of said rock rests on a large pine stump. The line from said stake shall run South on a true line variation twenty one one-half 20½ degrees East, to the meander line of the Columbia River.
