F. E. Jackson to J. E. Blaylock

This indenture made this 20. day of October 1908 by and between F. E. Jackson and
Sophia Jackson, his wife, of the County of Skamania, State of Washington, and J. E. Blaylock of
Multnomah County, State of Oregon, witnesses.

That in consideration of the covenants hereinafter contained on the part of the said J. E. Blaylock
to be kept and performed by him, the said F. E. Jackson and Sophia Jackson his wife,
do hereby lease, demise and let unto the said J. E. Blaylock, his heirs and executors,
administrators and assigns, the following described tract and piece of land to-wit:
A strip of land being sufficiently wide to construct and operate a single or double track
standard gauge logging railway over, through and across over from in Skamania County
Washington, the same being the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of the Northeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 23 Town 2 North
5 East W. M., and strip of land to be used as a right of way upon which to construct
and operate a logging railroad, the same to be sufficiently wide to construct and operate
a single or double track standard gauge logging railway as the same is now, or may
hereafter be located and constructed over through and across and upon said parcel
To have and to hold the same to the said J. E. Blaylock, his executors, administrators
and assigns for the term of fifteen (15) years, from the 20th day of October 1908
the said J. E. Blaylock, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns paying therefor
the sum of Seventy five (\$75.00) Dollars in gold coin for said term of fifteen years.
It is agreed however that upon the termination of said lease by expiration of the time
herein limited, that the said J. E. Blaylock, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns,
unless said lease is continued in force for a longer period, will remove the said railroad
iron and ties, and other railroad property from said premises.

And it is further agreed that if the said J. E. Blaylock, his heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns shall cease to operate said railroad prior to the expiration of their lease,
and shall remove all railroad property from said premises that their lease shall be
considered at an end and the right of way immediately revert to the lessors herein.
It is agreed that the right of way hereby leased becomes a part of the covenants

right of way over which to build a railroad from the Columbia River to the timbered lands of said J. E. Blyskal and that the same shall appertain to the said timbered lands, and a sale thereof shall carry with it the right of way for the same herein provided, and upon the terms and conditions herein stated.
