

George A. Simonds and Sam Sampson.

Okenowith Kamania P. Wash. May 2 1899

This Contract entered into between George A. Simonds of the first part and Sam Sampson of the second part.

George A. Simonds of the first part agrees to furnish to Sam Sampson of the second part at his Mill on Moss Creek what Cedar timber that is fit for shingle Bolts in his N. W. quarter section of section 26 Township 4 North of range 9 east.

Sam Sampson of the Second Part agrees to take said Bolts at his boom and pay .35c per thousand shingles for what shingles is in said timber.

Sam Sampson of the Second Part agrees to pay at the 15th of every month what timber was cut in the month before.

The said Sam Sampson agree to stand responsible for enough Bolts cut in the woods to keep Sam running and the said George A. Simonds to pay for the cutting of these said Bolts.

George A. Simonds of the First Part agrees to keep enough Bolts at the Mill to keep it running from present date untill timber is all cut.
