To the party of the first part does by these presents grant, bargain, sell, and convey unto the said party of the second part and to its successors and assign all of the following described personal property situated in Skamania and Clarke Counties, State of Washington, to wit;

About five thousand (500,000) feet of logs in the Washougal river in said County and State.

Between the dam of the party of the first part in said river in Section Eleven (11) Township Two 2 North Range Five (5) East of the Willamette Meridian and the mouth of said river: Said logs being marked W.W. on the side of each log and on the end of each log & the said logs so transferred -----

being all the logs in said river between said points, marked as aforesaid, and belonging to the party of the first part.

To have and to hold all and singular the said goods and chattels above bargained and sold, or intended so to be the said party of the second part and to its successors and assign forever, and the said party of the first part for itself its successors and assign, does covenant and agree to and with the said party of the second part and its successors and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of the said goods and chattels and every part thereof hereby made unto the said party of the second part and to its successors and assigns against all and every person and persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
