Wash Ter. also the said party of the first part includes in this sale to said party of the second part all of the Bar fixture tables chairs,, Pigeon hole tables tumblers, bottles and glassware and all wines liquors and beer together with said building and every thing there in consideration for the right and use of said party of the second part and the said parties of the first part hereby agree to warrant and defend the title of the same unto the said party of the second part against the claim of all persons whatsoever.
