The wood flume now owned by me and known as the Michael Lynott flume said flume having its starting point at the Columbia river running thence in a North-erly direction through the lands of J. M. Sweeney to the point where the water is taken from, with all of its spurs and branches the same being in Township 3 north of Range 8 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Skamania County, Washington, and I agree to warrant and do hereby warrant and agree to defend the title hereto.
