60 cords more or less of Hard wood cut by Harry Lamont on the lands of the aforesaid Sheperdson, for the said Buyle, Pooler & Co. also the following, one set of double Harness , one cook stove and cooking utensels and all of our right title and interest in and to a certain pair of horses bought by us of Murphy Jordan & Co,

To have and to hold to the said P.J. Quesinberry and to his heirs and assigns forever.
