

JACKSON CROUCH TO J. T. PETERS & CO.

Know all men by these presents, that I Jackson Crouch of the County of Skamania and State of Washington party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars to me in hand paid by Joseph T. Peters & Co of the County of Wasco, State of Oregon, parties of the Second part the receipt of which I hereby acknowledge, have this day bargained, sold and transferred and by these presents do bargain, sell, and transfer unto the said parties of the second part all of the following personal property towit:

Four Hundred (400) cords of Fir cord wood now lying on my Ranch in Skamania County, Washington, the same being in Sec. 25 & 36 Township 3 North of Range 7½ West of the Willamette Meridian, said wood to be delivered on the Columbia River beach at the mouth of Nelson Creek flume and to be loaded by the scow "Interstate" To have and to hold to the said Joseph T. Peters & Co. and to their heirs & assigns forever.
