

Monroe Vaillett and Wilson Cropper Co

This agreement made this 23rd August 1899 between Monroe Vaillett, party of the first part, and Wilson, Cropper and Company parties of the second part, witnesseth:

That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve Do^{rs} per annum, payable annually in advance, the first payment to be made on the 10th of September 1899, grants to the parties of the second part a right of way for a flume, across a certain tract of land, known as Rock Creek Island, said right of way to be twenty-six feet wide as follows, to-wit: six feet on East side of flume, said flume not to be moved in an Easterly direction after being built. Right of way to cease with the Rock Creek Mill.
