The mill known as Imans mill with all machinery thereunto belonging all now in my possession at the place last aforesaid to have and to hold the same unto the party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns forever.

And I do for myself my heirs and administrators, covenants and agree to and with the party of the second his executors, administrators and assigns to warrant and defend the sale of said property goods and chattel hereby made unto the said party of the second part his executors administrators and assigns

against all and every person and persons whomsoever.
