C. Robinson all of the following personal property lying and being in the County of Skamania and State of Washington more particularly described as follows towit:

335 cords of Fir wood lying and being on the Homestead of P. Shepardon in Township 3 North of Range 8 East of W. M. the same being the wood cut by myself and Buyle, Pooler & Co.

Also 40 cords of Hard wood lying on the above described premises and cut by Buyle, Pooler & Co.

Also Six (6) head of six year old Steers, the same being the steers bought by myself of George Miller and giving the said George Miller marked in right ear said steers now being or running on the Ranch of the said miller.
