

The H. C. Albee Co. (inc.) with Wilson Cropper & Co.

Portland, Oregon, June 26th 1899

Received of The H. C. Albee Co. (Incorporated) of Portland, Oregon, at its warehouse at or near Stevenson, Wash. the following goods.

One double drum log haul with 2 - 6 inch x 6 spin wheels each on a $3\frac{1}{8}$ shaft, 2 grooved drums, one on each shaft, one $2\frac{1}{16}$ shaft with pinion, one pair clutch couplings with lever,*

$3\frac{1}{8}$, about 240 ft long link log haul up chain, chain* with idlers, all with proper shafts, boxes etc boxes, collars etc to make all complete.

under the following conditions, to-wit: C. Wilson agrees to pay them the sum of Two Hundred fifty five Dollars in U. S. Gold Coin for the said goods, in the following installments, to-wit: Ten Dollars, on delivery of said goods, balance as follows:

One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars Sept 15th after date

One Hundred Thirty Dollars Nov 15th after date with interest on the whole amount unpaid at the rate of ten per cent per annum. This expressly understood and agreed that until the said sum of Two Hundred Fifty five Dollars, with interest thereon as aforesaid is paid, the said goods are to remain the property of The H. C. Albee Co. (Incorporated) and C. Wilson have no power or right to dispose of the same. But when all of said sum of Two Hundred Sixty Five Dollars, with interest thereon as aforesaid is paid, then the title of said goods is to vest in C. Wilson.

This also agreed that in the event that C. Wilson shall fail to pay either of said installments at maturity the said The H. C. Albee Co. (Incorporated) may at their option take possession of said goods and cancel this contract on refunding the money already paid by C. Wilson after deducting therefrom Twenty five Dollars, per rent and expense of removal and the sum of Twenty five Dollars, as liquidation and assessed damages, which C. Wilson hereby promise to pay said. The H. C. Albee Co. (Incorporated) in the event that he shall fail to perform the terms of this agreement. It is also agreed that said goods are not to be removed from location as stated above without consent of said The H. C. Albee Co. (Incorporated) being first obtained.
