12" Hemlock N12 1/2°W-10.3' scribed 1/8 S31BT

R/R spike in base of 14" D-Fir S75E-15.0' to spike.

Both BT's have a 1" Brass disk stamped LS 16337.

Set guard posts East & West with decals 54-2 & survey marker.

Nailed 54-9 & BT signs to BT's & painted band & blazes red.
